

The Ministry of Meteorology signs four memorandums of cooperation to enhance community partnership and support weather and climate awareness



The National Center of Meteorology (NCM) has signed four memorandums of cooperation with a number of specialized entities and associations, as part of the second coordination meeting of influencers and those interested in weather and climate, in a step aimed at expanding the scope of community partnerships and enhancing integration with non-profit sector institutions, in a way that contributes to raising the level of awareness of weather and climate, and reducing the risks associated with weather phenomena.

The memorandums of cooperation included Ajwa, the Saudi Scientific Meteorological Society, the Al-Saiqa Search and Rescue Society, and the Hattan volunteer team, based on the center's orientation towards building effective partnerships with the relevant authorities, and activating joint initiatives that serve the community.

The memoranda aims to enhance areas of cooperation, exchange of experiences and knowledge, coordinate efforts in the implementation of awareness and training programs, support community initiatives, and benefit from the capabilities available to various entities in order to enhance the dissemination of meteorological culture, raise awareness of risks associated with weather phenomena, enhance prevention and response, and support the safety of lives and property.

The Center stressed that these memoranda come as an extension of its efforts to consolidate the principle of partnership and integration with community institutions, and expand the areas of cooperation with specialized authorities, in order to achieve the goals of disseminating reliable meteorological information, raising community readiness to deal with weather phenomena, and benefiting from shared experiences in the implementation of initiatives and programs with a sustainable impact.
