

The CEO follows up the work of the center in the field and is briefed on the third phase of the data of roads and ports



The CEO of the National Center of Meteorology, Dr. Ayman bin Salem Ghulam, followed up on the operational and field works of the center in the holy sites, as part of the center's efforts to support the operational work system during the Hajj season, and to improve the quality of services provided to the authorities concerned with serving the pilgrims.

During his tour, he was briefed on the progress of the third phase concerned with weather data and weather phenomena for the ports and roads leading to Madinah, and the mechanisms for updating weather information and related climate data, in order to enhance the readiness of the concerned authorities to facilitate and leave the pilgrims safely.

The CEO stressed the importance of integration between the technical and field teams, and the continuation of raising the level of readiness around the clock until the departure of the pilgrims, in order to achieve the center's goals in supporting the work of the Hajj season, and providing accurate and reliable meteorological services that contribute to supporting the relevant authorities and serving the pilgrims of the Holy House of God.
