

The Kingdom chaired the 39th meeting of the Arab Permanent Committee for Meteorology in Cairo



The **CEO of the National Center of Meteorology, Dr. Ayman bin Salem Ghulam**, headed today, the Kingdom's delegation and the work of the thirty-ninth meeting of the Arab Standing Committee for Meteorology, which was held at the headquarters of the General Secretariat of the League of Arab States in Cairo, with the participation of representatives of Arab member states.
