

Joint team to benefit the Kingdom from the new generation of Chinese satellites



The Chief Executive Officer of the National Center of Meteorology (NCM) and Head of the Asia Region of the World Meteorological Organization (WMO), Dr. Ayman bin Salem Ghulam, held a meeting today (Thursday) with the Permanent Representative of the People's Republic of China to the WMO, Dr. Chen Qinlin, on the sidelines of the 79th session of the World Meteorological Organization (WMO) held in Geneva.

During the meeting, they discussed activating the terms of the memorandum of understanding signed between the Kingdom and China in the field of meteorology, including capacity building, exchange of technical expertise, benefiting from Chinese progress in employing artificial intelligence to serve meteorological work, in addition to supporting cooperation in the field of satellites, especially benefiting from the Chinese satellite "Fengyun-4B", where it was agreed to form a joint working team to study the technical situation and provide appropriate support from the Chinese side.
